

## Job Posting- Maternal Child Health, COHI, CPNP

### **Summary:**

Maternal child health works collegially with the community Health nurse on a day-to day basis, the position provides direct support to youth, pregnant and post natal women, infants and children. The position provides support to the community health nurse with Maternal Child health programming, e.g. immunization, well child clinics, and nutrition support and liaises with community members regarding health centre programs.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Work with various persons within and outside of community to offer a full range of community-based health promotion, education and support services to families.
- Children's oral Health Initiative (COHI) annual screens to children 0-7 includes fluoride varnish, sealants and temporary fillings to prevent early childhood tooth decay.
- The Canada Prenatal Nutrition Program (CPNP) provides funding to the community groups to help improve the health of pregnant women, new mothers and their babies who face challenges that put their health at risk, such as poverty, teen pregnancy, social and geographic isolation.
- Drive mother and baby to medical appointments as needed
- Check in on new mothers
- Fill out check requisitions as needed and hand in to health director
- Do monthly work plans and report to Health Director
- Keep all files confidential according to policy
